

SUICIDE PREVENTION Among LGBTQ YOUTH

A workshop about the prevention of suicide among lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or questioning youth. The workshop is intended for youth suicide prevention program staff and professionals who work with youth directly, such as child welfare staff, teachers, clergy, group home staff, juvenile justice services staff, foster parents, therapists and recreation workers.

The workshop was developed by the national Suicide Prevention Resource Center. It will cover terminology and data for LGBTQ suicidal behavior, risk and protective factors, agency/school assessment for LGBTQ cultural competence, and changes in policy and practice that help prevent suicide among LGBTQ youth.
