# Where to Sign Up for Vaccine Appointments:

#### Alert Houston:

Houstonians can sign up to receive COVID-19 vaccine appointment updates from the Houston Health Department via email, text, voice call, or mobile push notifications, by registering for the "HoustonRecovers" subscription of Alert Houston <a href="https://houstonemergency.org/alerts/">https://houstonemergency.org/alerts/</a>

### **Houston Emergency**:

Vaccination portal for the City of Houston, you can sign up for appointments here. All vaccine appointments with the City of Houston are filled through January 2021, but keep checking to see if any new appointments may open or sign up for alert notifications through Alert Houston.

A list of all vaccination provider sites in Texas and how many doses of the vaccine they have on hand. If you cannot sign up through a large vaccination hub, you can use this map to find a community vaccine provider (such as a pharmacy, local clinic, or doctor's office) with available vaccine doses and then contact them directly about scheduling an appointment.
